Veksø has won the prestigious German design award Red Dot 2009 in the category "Product design" for the SOLID-series of urban elements and LED lighting fixtures. From the inspiration in "raw" industrial products in concrete the SOLID-series is developed and detailed to show the modern fiber concretes possibilities.

The series is designed with the focus on best possible balance between design, craftsmanship and sustainability. As a material the fiber concrete gives obvious advantages in the urban space where strong and minimal maintenance products are required.

The series is designed by schmidt hammer lassen, design, division of schmidt hammer lassen, architects, who has designed many prestigious developments in Denmark as well as internationally.

The series entitle various products such as: bicycle rack, bollard, litterbin with or without ashtray, round resting bench with a possible planter space in the middle and last but not least a bollard and a park lighting fixture fitted with LED. All the products have a base of fiber concrete and a top section of steel that varies depending of the function of the product. This rational idea gives not only flexibility in the production but also make a simple and quick exchange possible damaged parts without exchanging either the concrete or steel if needed.
